## **Move over Darling** **James Garner and Doris Day**

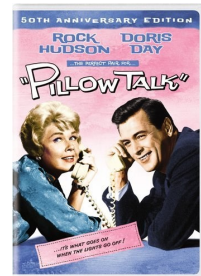
