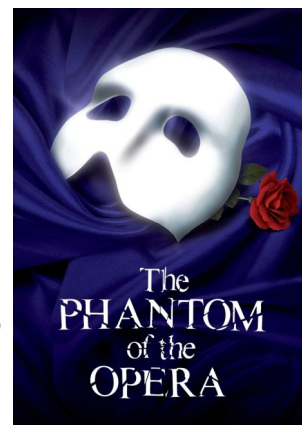
Family Camp
