Laundry Reminder:

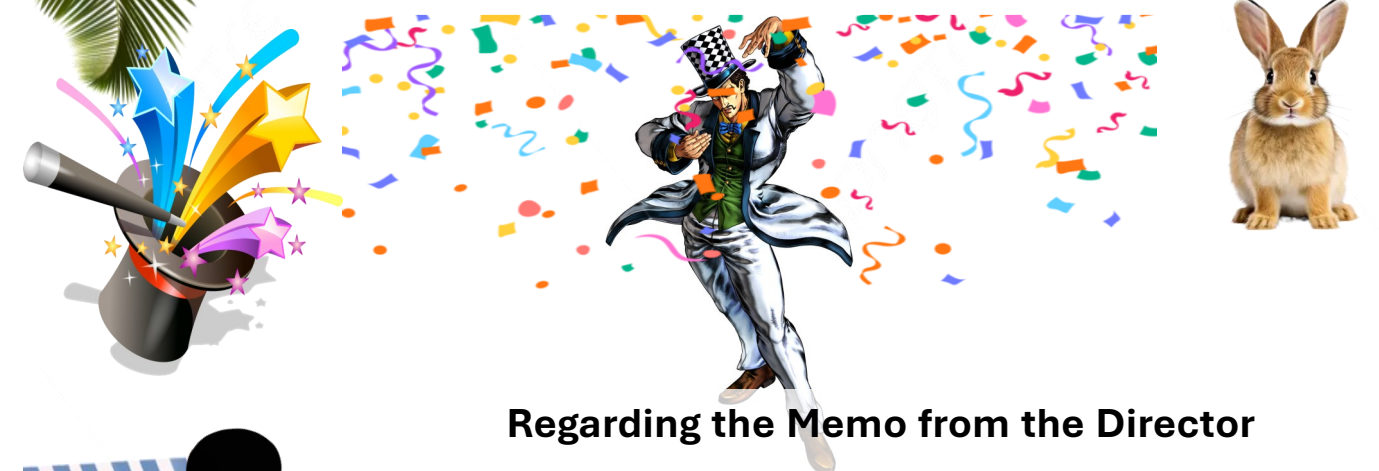
You need to **tap your card twice** on the laundry machine panel.

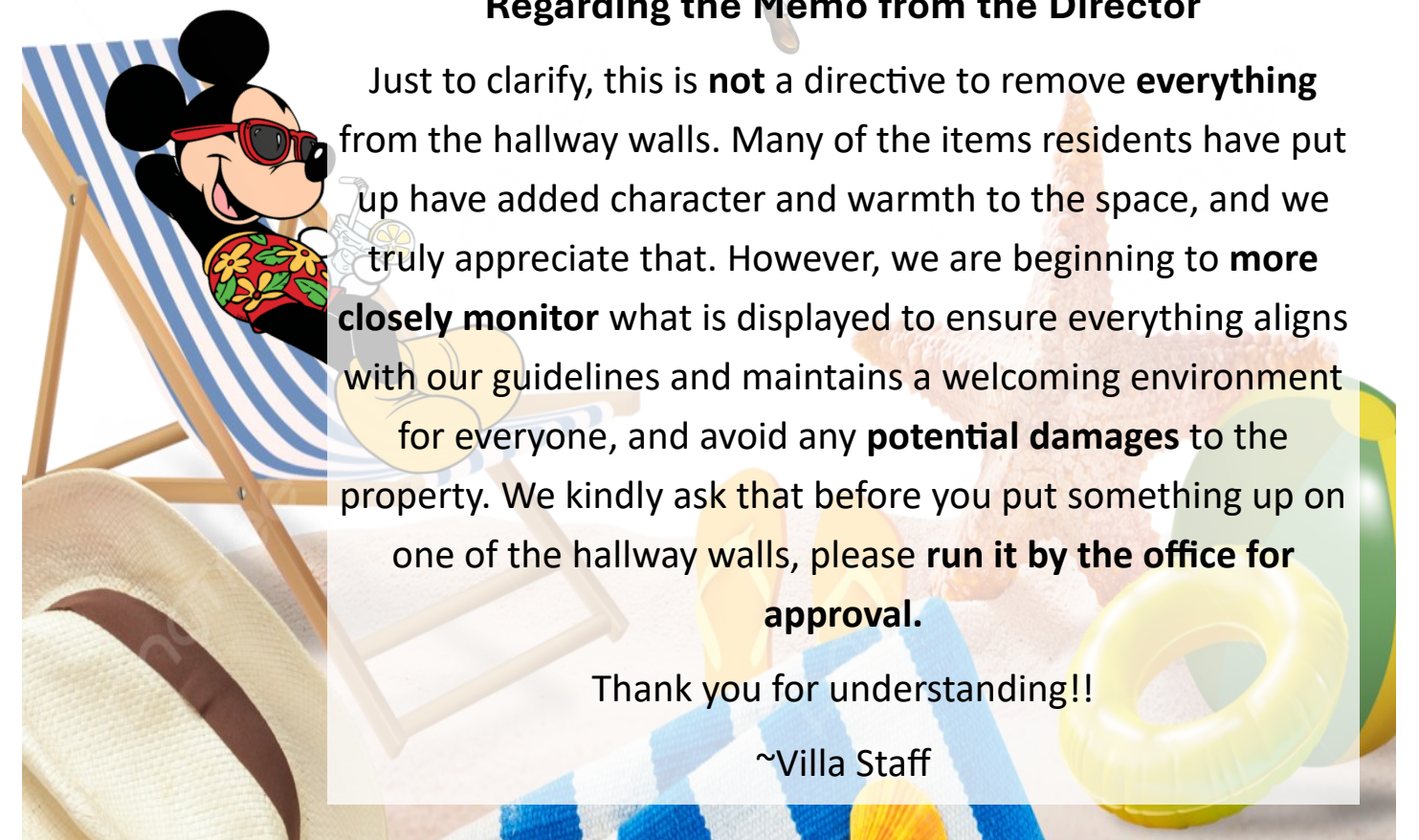


Regarding the Memo from the Director
